Objectives

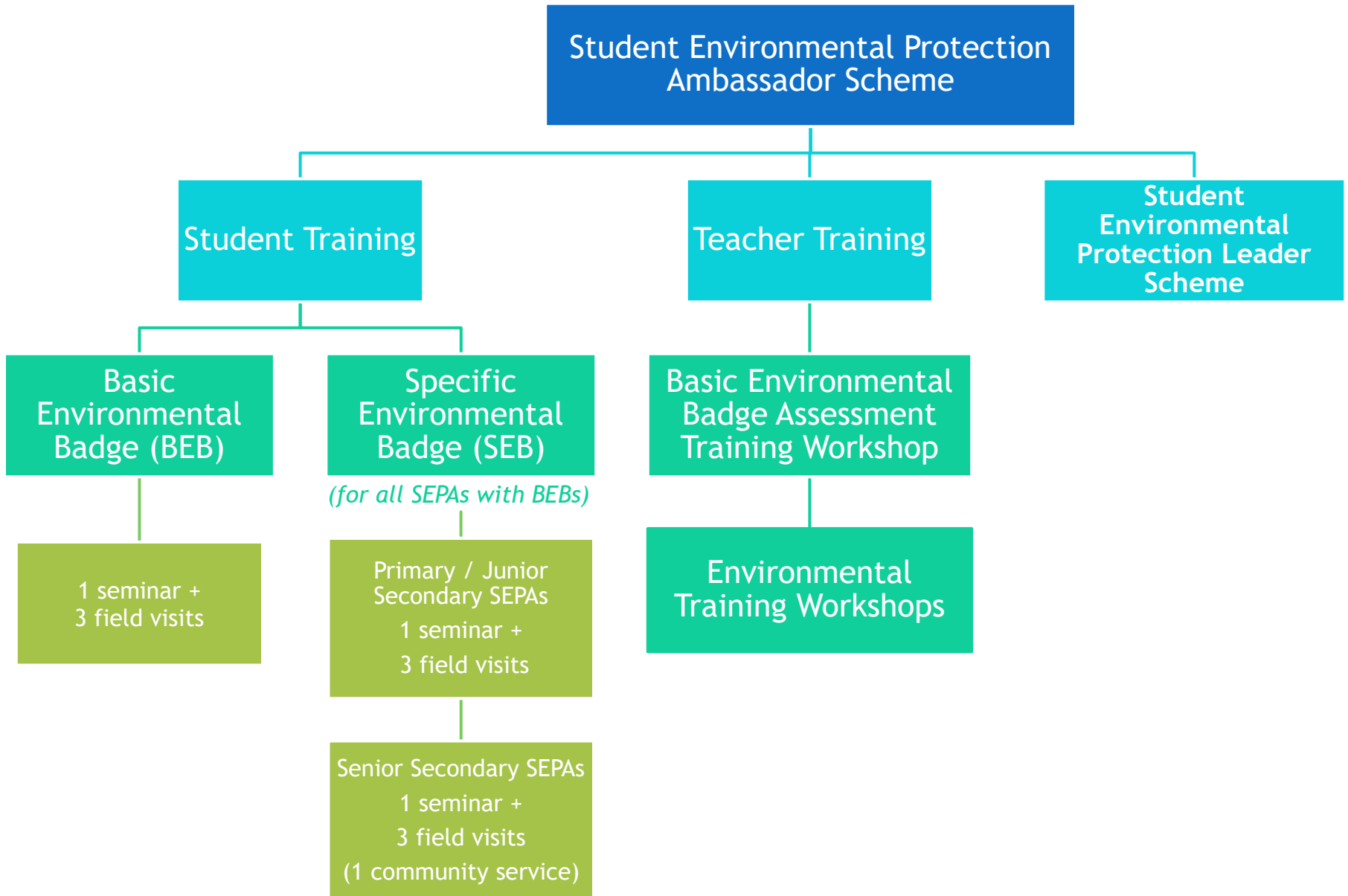
- To develop in students *a sense of responsibility* towards the environment

- ▶ Students will remain as SEPAs until the completion of their primary/secondary education.

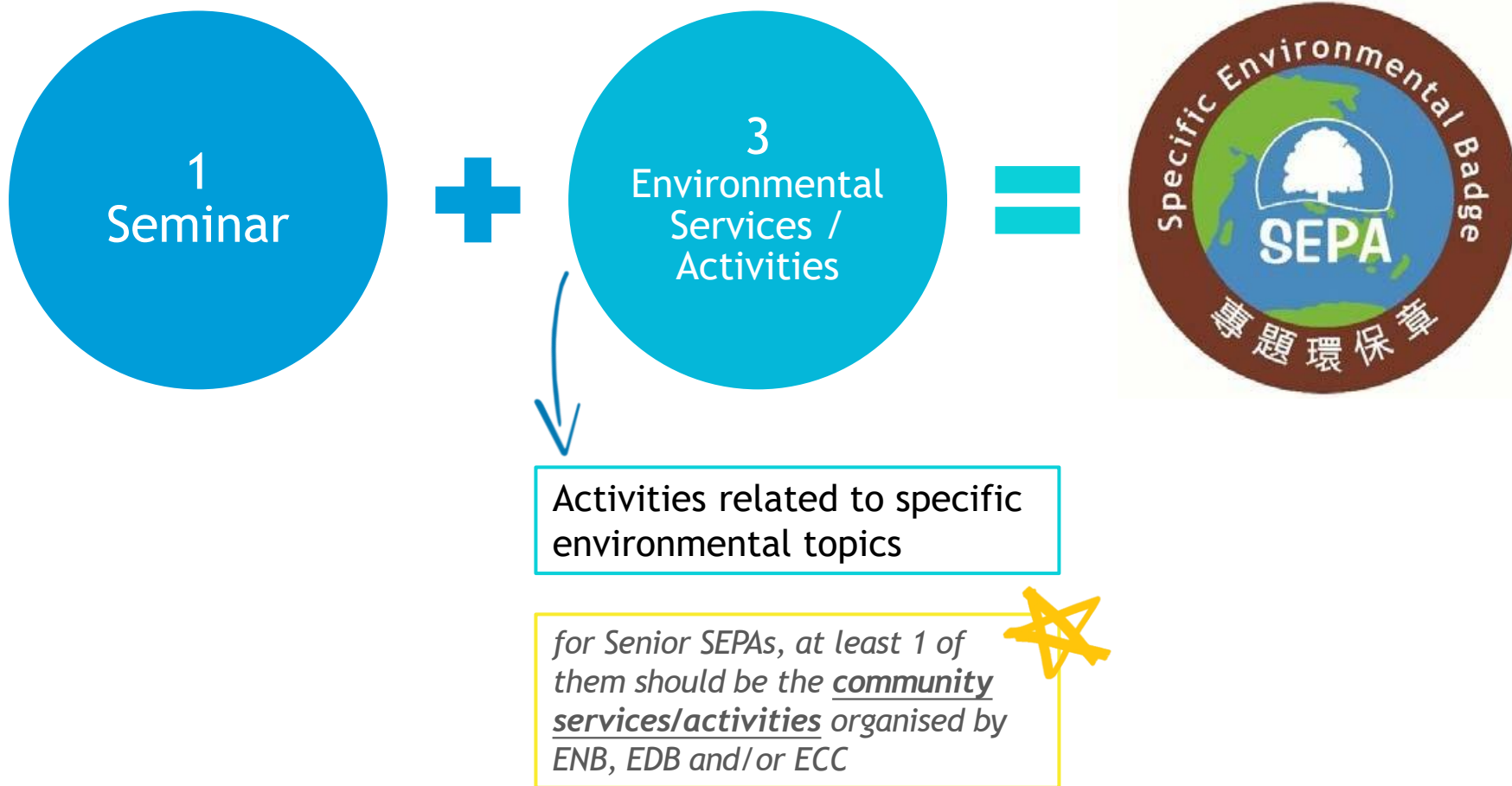

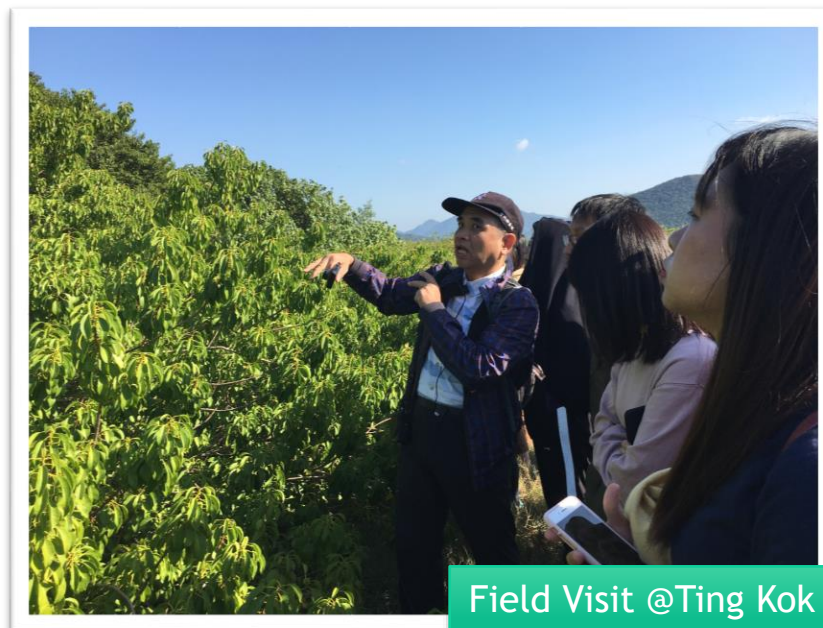

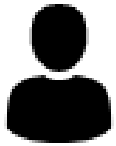
